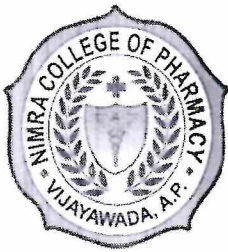
Gender:

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
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celebrations, Education Summit and many more such events help the girl students to identify their potential in leadership and entrepreneurship.

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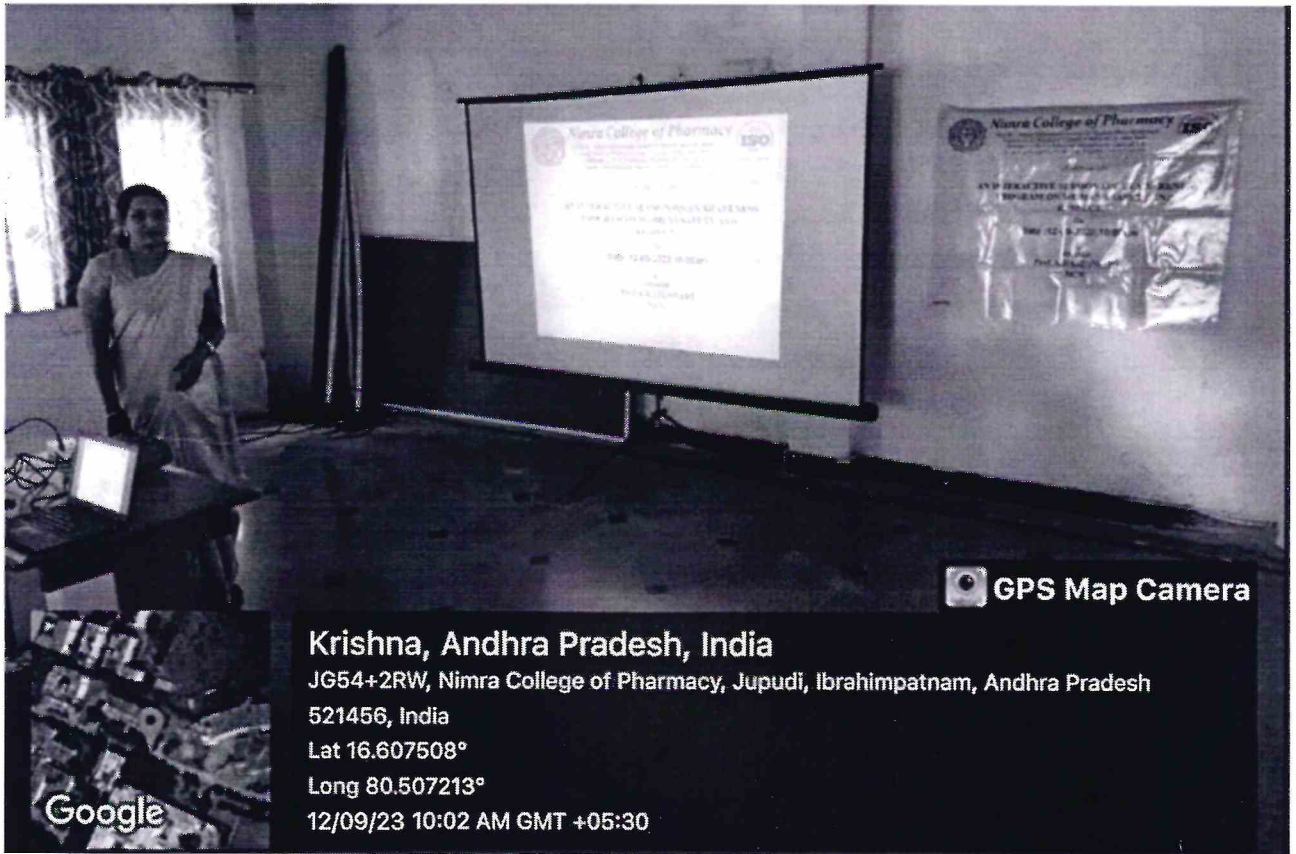
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Outcome Of the program :

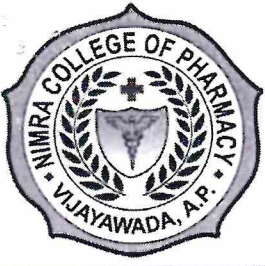

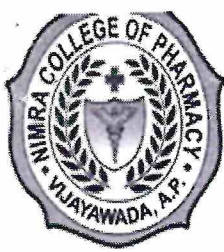

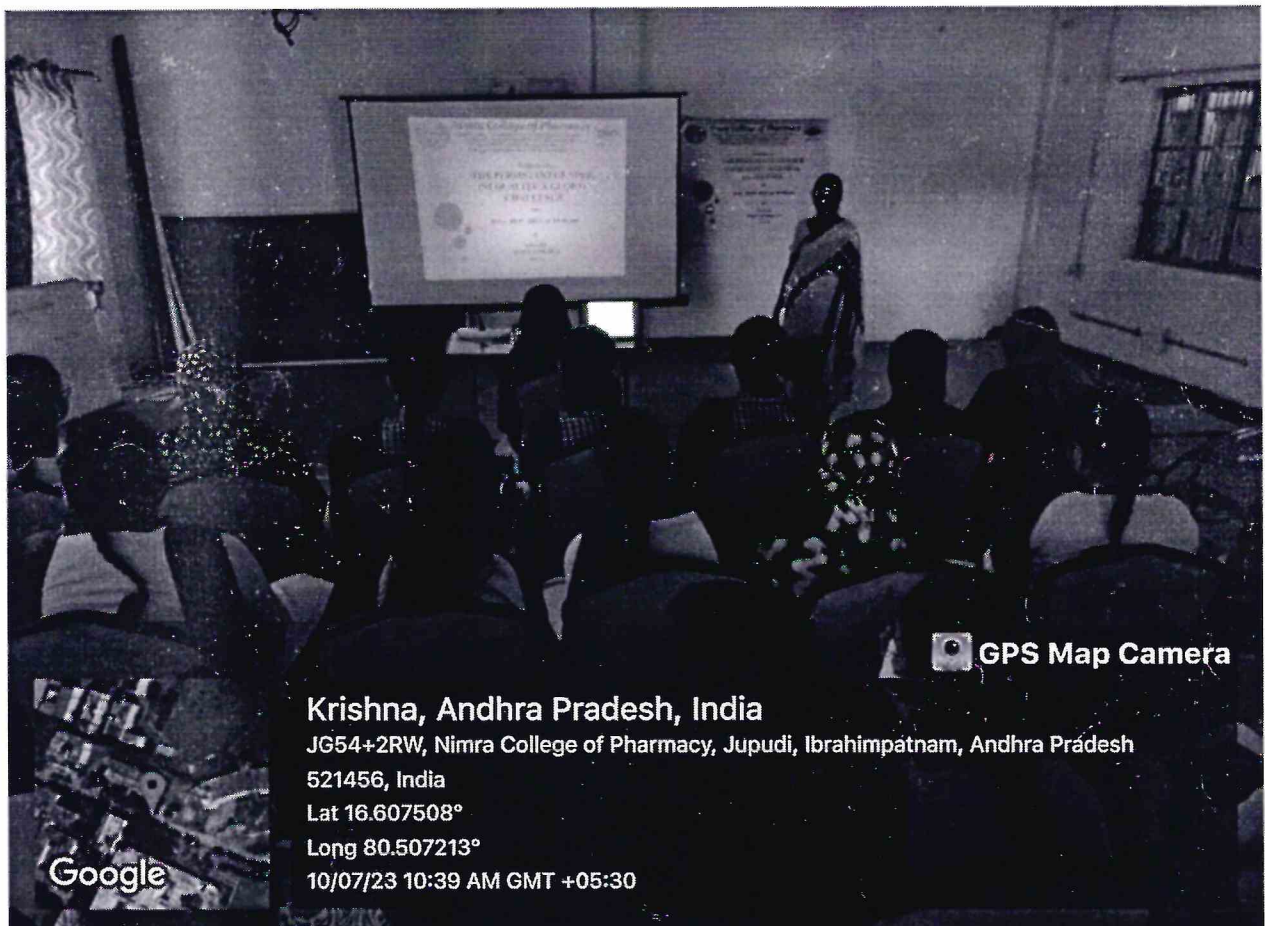
