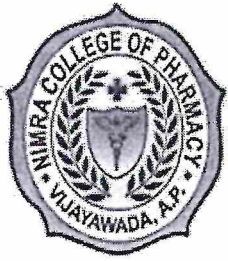
Objective of the program:

It is statistically significant if the p-value of the data analysis is less than the prespecified alpha (significance level). In our example the p-value is 0.02, which is less than the prespecified alpha of 0.05 so the researcher concludes there statistical significance for the study a measurement of how likely it is that the difference between 2 groups models or statistics occurred by chance or occurred because 2 variables are actually related to each other.




Alumni Meeting Report (12-08-2023)

Drug Repurposing and Why?

Total Global Spending on R&D
(2014-2023: 247 Billion \$)
Total Number of Research/Disease Areas: 309

For every 100 drugs entering phase I trials, around 60 advanced to phase II trials, just over 20 entered phase III trials, and only about 12 gained FDA approval (Joseph et al., 2016)

"Capital costs and expenditures on drugs that fail to reach the market: \$1 billion to more than \$2 billion".

Costs for the development of a new drug: US\$ 2-3 billion (Nosengo, 2016).

The cost of bringing a repurposed drug: US\$ 300 million.
